### CMD POLICY

A new CMD policy has been introduced for all ministers within the Diocese. This can be found at [www.leicester.anglican.org](http://www.leicester.anglican.org)

Clergy will notice some differences in the new policy – for example whilst the amount of yearly financial support remains the same, it is no longer automatically transferrable from one year to the next. This is now a discretionary decision, and based upon best use of resources and available finance.

Part of the development of the ministerial review process in 2011 will see the introduction of 'Personal Development Plans'. These act as a simple, but effective means of identifying what is needed in ministerial development, and help find the best resource for that development. There are examples on the diocesan website, on the School for Ministry pages.

Those seeking a sabbatical are also advised to read the new guidance notes, also available on the School for Ministry web pages, as changes have been made in the light of Common Tenure, and available finance. There is now a clearer application process, focussed around April and November of each year.

Finally we are always interested in learning about courses or training events, and there will be a link on the ministry webpages for feedback from external courses.
